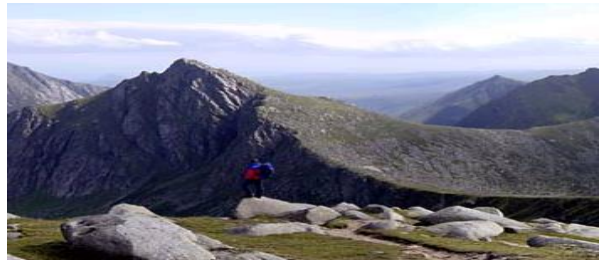

Fortunately Shelly had a weak signal on her mobile phone and managed to alert rescue services. Within several minutes of making the call a helicopter arrived and airlifted the couple to safety.
